What is the Veterans Welcome Home Program?

The New England Center and Home for Veterans (NECHV) Veterans Welcome Home Program provides housing search assistance and ongoing supportive services to ensure that Veterans achieve and maintain stabilization in the community. Participants in this program are identified by the city of Boston, MA and then outreached by providers throughout the Boston area to engage them in such services. Veterans enrolled in this program will be assigned to a case manager, and will complete an initial intake as well as an Integrated Service Plan to identify the Veteran's unique circumstances as well as goals to help them live independently in his or her prospective community.

In participating in Veterans Welcome Home, Veterans will receive support including but not limited to housing search, outreach to landlords, transportation to viewings, assistance with moving and moving costs, connection and/or referrals to benefits, education and employment opportunities, etc. Such resources may be utilized within NECHV, or through other organizations in the community. Involvement with these services are voluntary, but are otherwise long-term.
